

Installing Orchard Math at home.

These are the CD disks you will use and the order of their installation.

Disk 1 - Orchard Database Installer
Disk 2 - Installation Code CD

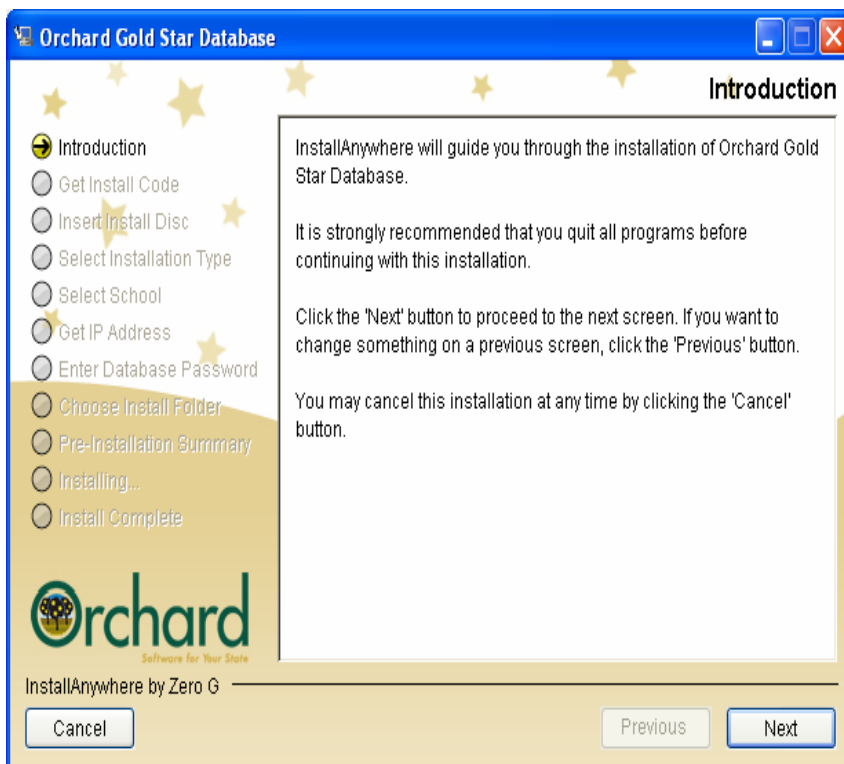
Disk 3 - Orchard Manager CD1
Disk 4 - Orchard Manager CD2

Disk 3 - Orchard Manager CD1
Disk 5 - Math K-3
Disk 6 - Math 4-6
Disk 7 - Math & Science

Disk 8 - Hot Fix

Installing Orchard Math:

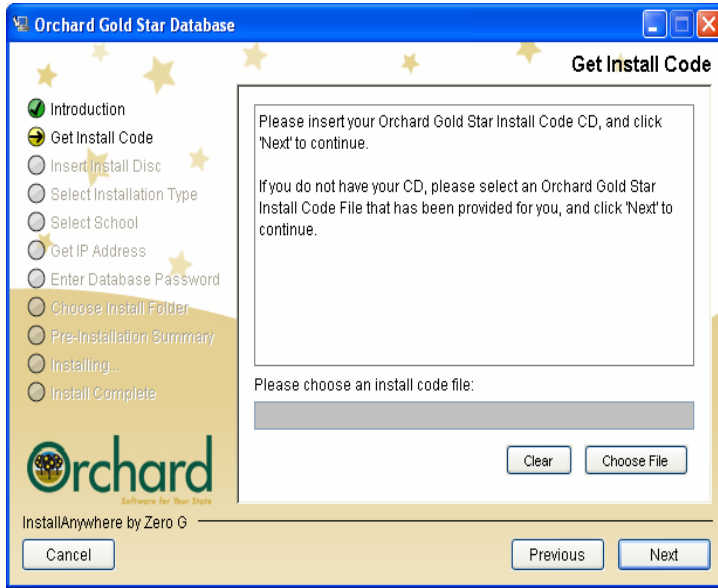
Insert **Disk 1** – Orchard Database Installer
Open the CD drive
Double click the Orchard CD and double click the install icon



This window will appear. It is suggested you close all other programs before continuing to install this program.

Click the **Next** button

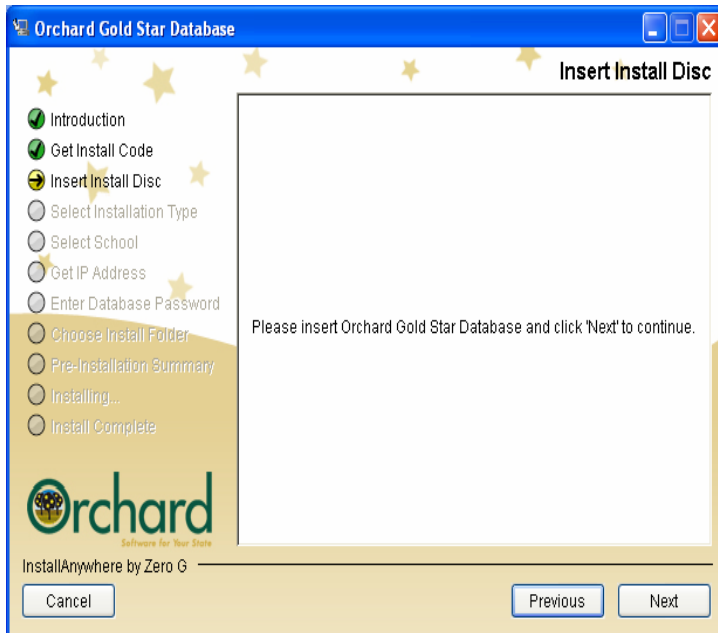
The next window will ask to you insert **Disk 2** – Installation Code CD



Insert **Disk 2**
Installation Code CD

Close the window for the CD

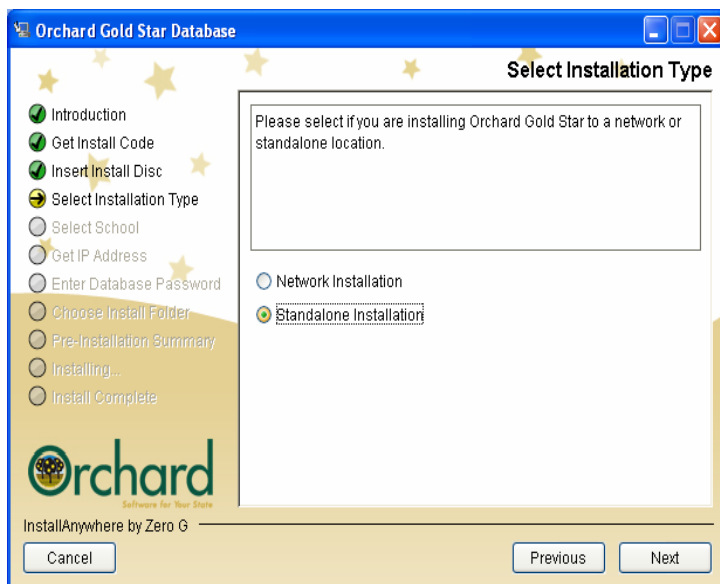
Click the **Next** button.



Remove **Disk 2** – place it in its sleeve

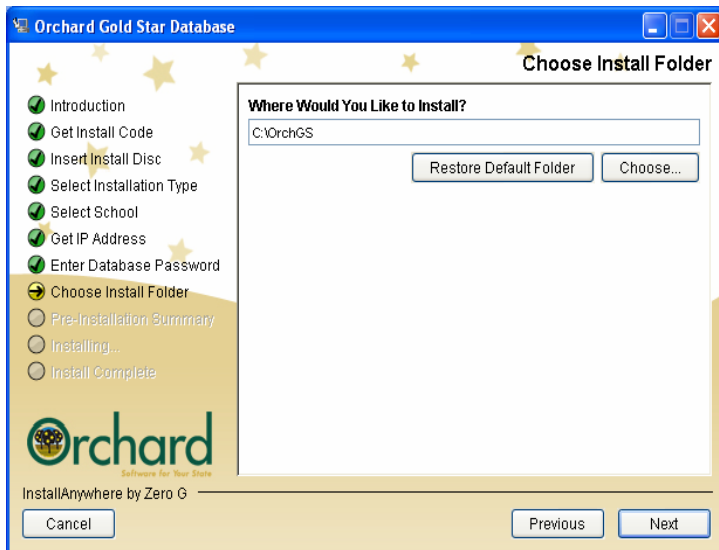
Insert **Disk 1** again
Orchard Database Installer

Click the **Next** button



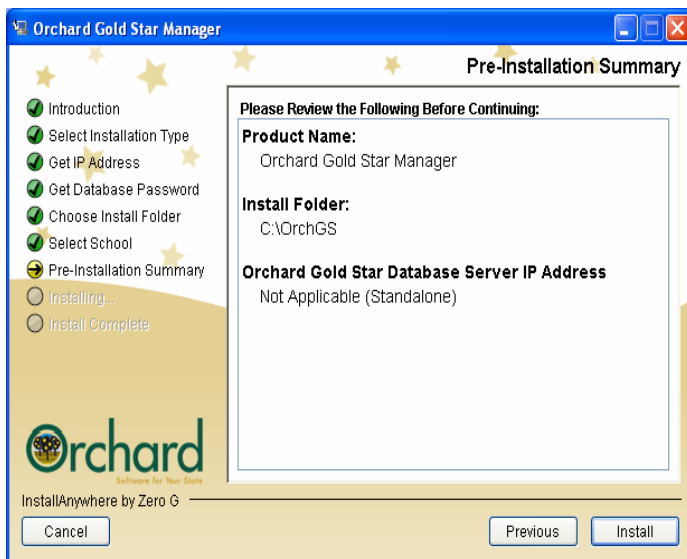
Click on the Stand alone option

Click the **Next** button



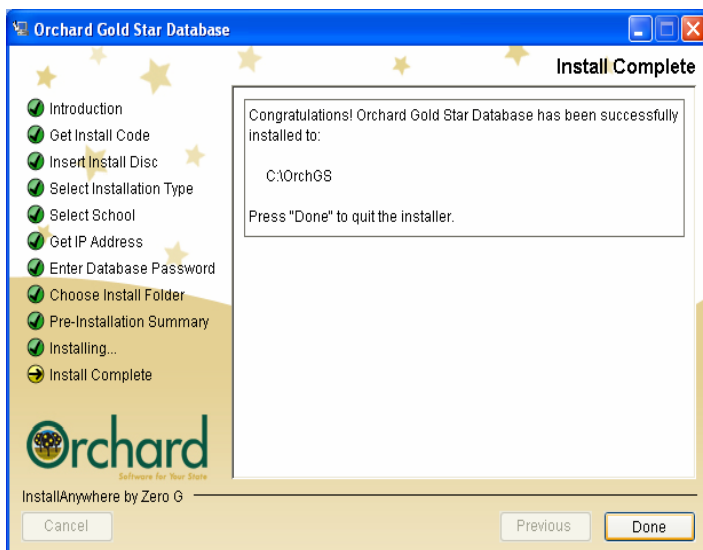
Orchard would like you to install at the root of the C drive but you may click the choose button and install in a location of your choice.

Click the **Next** button



Your window may not look exactly like this.

Click the **Install** button



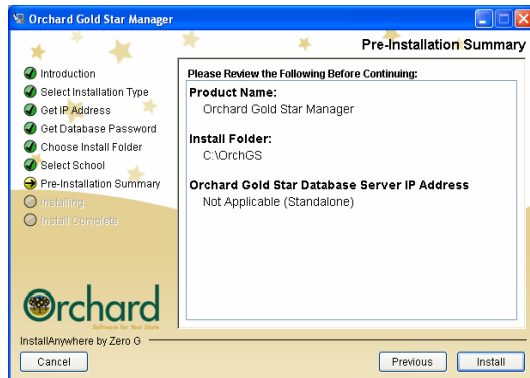
Orchard Math will install and present this window when the install is complete

Click the **Done** button

Remove **Disk 1** from the CD drive and place it in its sleeve opposite **Disk 2**

Insert **Disk 3** Orchard Manager CD 1

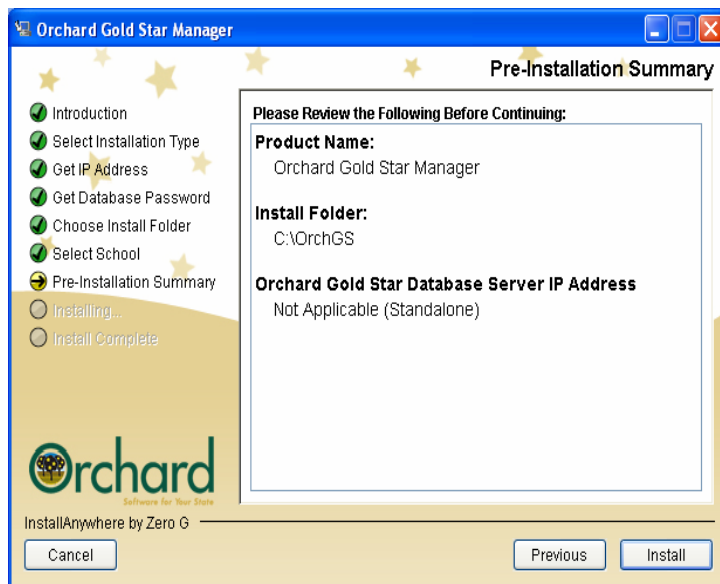
You may need to open the CD drive, double click the Orchard CD and double click the Install icon.



The first window you see will ask which Program you want to install. Click on the Orchard Gold Star Manager Install (if not already selected)

Click the **Install** button

At the Introduction screen, click Next to continue.



The Pre-Installation Summary window tells you where your install folder is located.

Click the **Install** button

The program will install (this will take a few minutes – please be patient) and then you may be asked to insert Orchard Gold Star Manager Disk 2 – labeled **Disk 4**

(We haven't tested the Mac install and so we are using the company directions – they say not to be concerned if you are not asked to use Orchard manager CD2.)

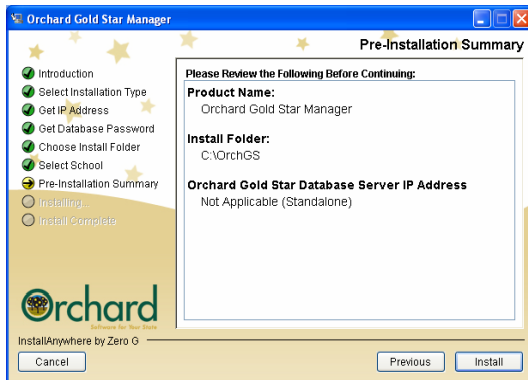
If asked to use Orchard Manager CD2 Remove **Disk 3**, insert **Disk 4** and click the **OK** button. Installation will continue.

At the Install Complete screen, click Done to close installer

Remove **Disk 4** - Orchard Manager Replace **Disk 3** and **Disk 4** in their sleeve

Insert **Disk 3** - Orchard Manager CD1 (yes, the same disk you used before)

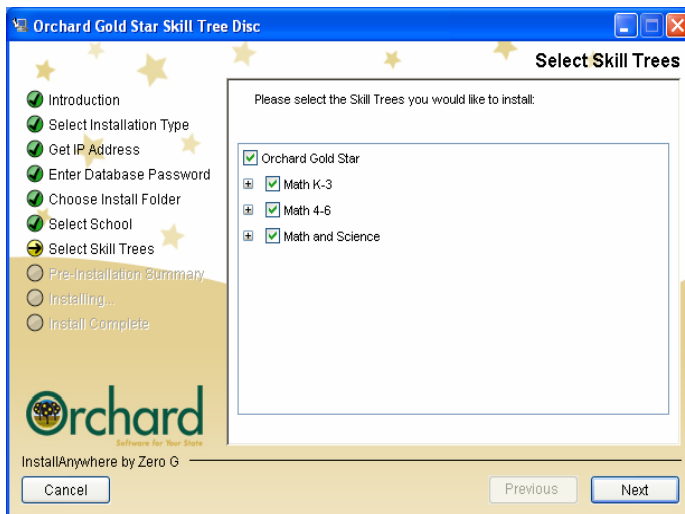
Open the CD and double click the Orchard CD and double click the Install icon



The first window you see will ask which Program you want to install. Click on the Orchard Gold Star Skill Tree Install

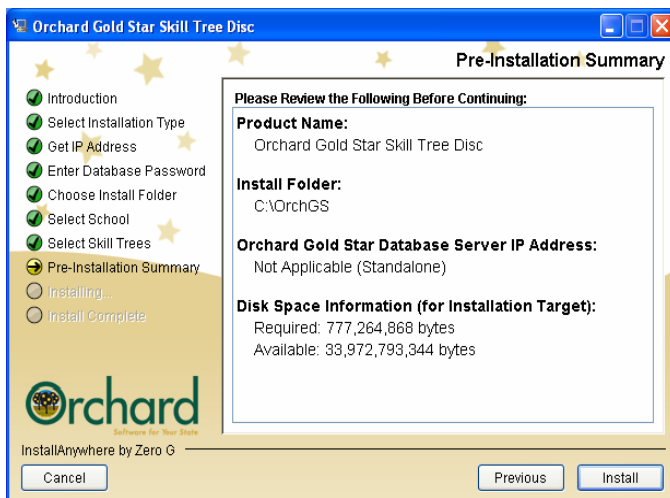
Click the **Install** button

At the Introduction screen, click Next to continue.



All of the listed items need to be checked. You will be installing all of them.

Click the **Next** button



The Pre-Installation Summary window opens.

Click the **Install** button

Installing will start

All most immediately you will asked to insert Math K-3

Remove **Disk 3** and insert **Disk 5** - Math K-3

Click the OK button after inserting **Disk 5**

Replace **Disk 3** in its sleeve

You can close the CD window if it opens

When prompted to insert Math 4-6

Remove **Disk 5** and insert **Disk 6** - Math 4-6

Click the OK button after inserting **Disk 6**

Replace **Disk 5** in its sleeve

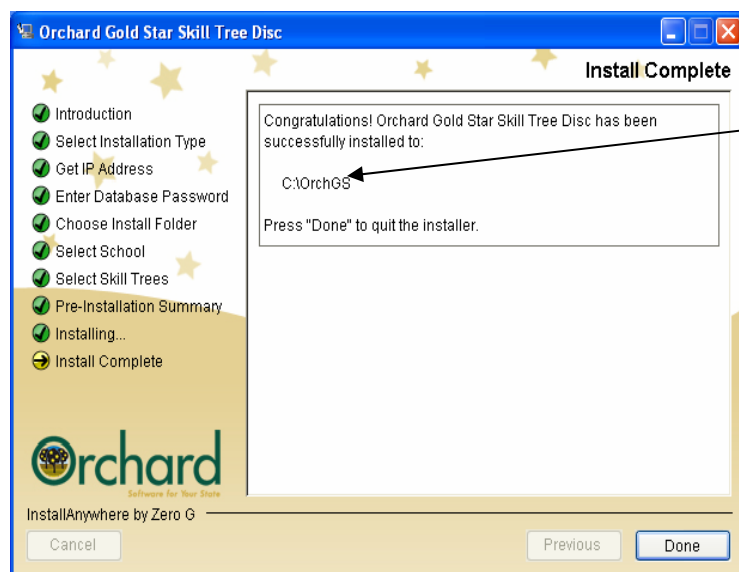
When prompted to insert Math & Science

Remove **Disk 6** and insert **Disk 7** - Math & Science

Click the OK button after inserting **Disk 7**

Replace **Disk 6** in its sleeve

You can close the CD window if it opens



Make note of where you installed Orchard

This example is C:\OrchGS which means you can open the C drive and find the OrchGS folder.

Click the **Done** button

Remove **Disk 7** and place it in the sleeve

Run **Disk 8 – Hot Fix** It should just start and run. If it doesn't open the CD drive and double click the **install.exe** file. Remove **Disk 8** and replace it in the sleeve with **Disk 7**.

Congratulations, you have successfully installed Orchard Math.
